Final Judgment

Revelation 20:11-15

Introduction: Revelation 20:11-15; 2 Peter 1:10 - Review

<u>The Final Judgment</u> — Revelation 20:11-13 - Daniel 7:9-10 - This judgment will finalize the punishment of <u>lost sinners</u> and the <u>degree</u> of their punishments. (Matthew 11:20-24, <u>Luke 12:47-48</u>; John 19:11b)

"Book of Life" - Daniel 12:1-2

"Judged, each according to what they had done" (20:13). Three questions: 'Who is judging?', 'Who is judged?', 'What is judged?'.

<u>The Ultimate Sentence</u> – Revelation 20:14-15 – The <u>second</u> death is the death that we must all be concerned with, it is eternal death in the <u>Lake of Fire</u>.

"Lake of Fire" - Valley of Ben-Hinnom or Topheth located southwest of Jerusalem. <u>First</u>, it is perpetual '<u>fire</u>'. <u>Second</u>, it is engulfed in total <u>darkness</u>. <u>Third</u>, it is a place where the <u>worm</u> does not die, and <u>finally</u>, a place of unending <u>sorrow and grief</u> filled with weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Conclusion: Saving <u>grace</u> will not be available forever, it will come to an end when the judgment arrives. (<u>Hebrews 10:26-32</u>)

God judges us according to <u>works</u>; for the <u>unrighteous</u> their works in the flesh and for the righteous their works of unrighteousness have been <u>paid</u> for by Jesus Christ at the cross. At the judgment seat of Christ the <u>works</u> of believers will be judged for their eternal value. (1 <u>Corinthians 3:12-15</u>; 2 Corinthians 5:10) All judgment is judgment of <u>works</u>.

Physical, <u>first</u>, death is the end of <u>chances</u> to repent and believe in Jesus Christ; and that should energize and challenge me to communicate the good news <u>clearly</u> and <u>faithfully</u>. The <u>second</u> death is final separation from God and from earthly loved ones; this should further energize and challenge me to <u>pray</u> and <u>testify</u> to the love and grace of God; the Good News.

Satan has played a serious role; <u>first</u>, as an <u>external</u> enemy and <u>secondly</u>, as an <u>internal</u> force for evil, wrong and compromise. He is very active in the west as he dominates <u>culture</u> and marginalizes the impact of the local Church. "In a fallen world like ours unity is no treasure to be purchased at the price of <u>compromise</u>. Loyalty to God, faithfulness to truth, and the preservation of a good conscience are jewels more precious than gold" (A.W. Tozer).
