## Practicing Christianity - II

Hebrews 13:7-19

**Introduction**: Our author brackets these following thirteen verses with two comments about those who <u>lead</u> these local house churches.

Submission - vs. 7 - Submission is oneness with the authority structures of God.

**Precept:** God is the only person due our <u>absolute</u> obedience but He calls upon us to have <u>submissive</u> spirits and attitudes to those who share and preach the Word of God.

Consistency - vs. 8 - Consistency is oneness with God's plans for you.

**Precept:** There is a grand contrast between the changeableness of <u>humanity</u> and the unchangeableness of <u>divinity</u>.

<u>Soundness</u> - vs. 9 - Soundness in doctrine is oneness with <u>God's Word</u>. The heart that is established with <u>grace</u> is the opposite of the heart that is established with <u>law</u>. (Romans 6:14-15)

**Precept:** The direction of the Church is related to its proximity to the <u>truth</u>. The closer we are to the truth of God's Word, the better we will be in directing our lives towards the <u>will</u> of God. Finally, the victory of the Church is directly related to the <u>obedience</u> of believers.

Worship - vs. 10-14 - Worship is oneness with and adoration of our <u>Creator</u>.

**Precept:** Worship is never only <u>symbolic</u> just as forgiveness of sin is never only symbolic. (<u>John 6:51-55</u>)

<u>Sacrifice</u> - vs. 15-16 - Sacrifice is oneness with God's call to serve Him and our fellow mankind by offering our <u>things</u> and <u>ourselves</u> for others.

**Precept:** Praise releases the <u>power</u> of God and frees us from the bondage of <u>emotional</u> turmoil. Sacrifice involves works as well as <u>praise</u>.

Obedience - vs. 17 - Obedience is oneness with God's <u>authority</u> structures.

**Precept:** God has a task for each part of the Church body. The <u>leaders</u> are to properly lead the flock and the flock is called to submissively <u>follow</u> the man of God.

**Conclusion**: The love and care of <u>God's people</u>, submission to the authority structures that <u>God has ordained</u>, purity of doctrine and pursuit of <u>truth and sound doctrine</u> summarize this list.

These final verses speak of <u>spiritual</u> authority (Remember and obey your leaders); the most important level of authority. We also read about '<u>spiritual</u> discernment'. The final instruction is found in verse 18, "<u>Pray for us</u>". The majority of these instructions relate to Church life and how our personal lives impact <u>Church</u> life.
